OBPS registration requirements

- Criteria for mandatory participants
 - Having reported 50 kt CO₂e or more to the GHGRP for 2014 or a subsequent reporting year
 - Are operating in a backstop jurisdiction
 - Undertaking an activity/producing a product for which an OBS is prescribed (i.e. a covered activity is undertaken)
- Considering opening OBPS to voluntary opt-in for 2019 for facilities:
 - Emitting 10-50 kt CO₂e (reported to the federal GHG Reporting Program for 2017 or a subsequent year);
 - Located in a backstop jurisdiction; and
 - Undertaking an activity/producing a product for which an OBS is prescribed.

OBPS registration: overview of process

- Online registration using existing GHGRP reporting application within ECCC's Single Window
- Existing GHGRP reporters will automatically have access
- Registration application form can be prepared in multiple sessions if needed (data retained)
- Submitted registrations will be reviewed by ECCC. Successful registrations will receive a Covered Facility Certificate by email from ECCC.
- The Covered Facility Certificate is required to register as an emitter with CRA and receive an **Exemption Certificate** which will allow for the delivery of charge-free fuel to the covered facility.

OPBS registration: ECCC timelines

- Facilities will need both certificates (Covered Facility and Exemption) in place by January 1, 2019 to avoid the fuel charge on purchased fuels.
- ECCC registration is targeted to start November 1, 2018.
- Recommend that stakeholders start the ECCC registration process as early in November as possible to avoid delays.
- Target date for facility registrations to be submitted: November 16, 2018
- Ensure that complete/detailed information is provided.
 ECCC review may take longer if follow up is required.

Registration information: responsible person

- The proposed approach based off of the regulatory framework will require the following information for the person responsible for the facility:
 - Legal name
 - English and French Trade Name
 - Federal Business Number
 - Physical address
 - Owner or operator
- Additional responsible persons can be identified on the registration form but the certificate will only be issued for the one submitting the registration application.

Registration information: authorized official

- Identify an authorized official
 - Name
 - Physical and mailing address
 - Job title
 - Email address, phone number
 - Proof of authority to act on behalf of the Responsible Person
- Note: submission of the application form will require the signature of the authorized official on a complete copy of the form.
- An additional contact person can be identified

Registration information: facility

- Information required for the facility:
 - Facility name
 - Physical address or geographical coordinates
 - NAICS Code, ECCC identifiers (GHGRP ID, NPRI ID)
 - Facility map
 - Annual total reported GHG emissions from 2014-2017
 - System will automatically pull data from GHGRP
 - If OPBS facility differs from what reported to GHGRP, a detailed explanation is required
 - Identification of the covered activity undertaken at the facility, details of the technology used to produce the product, and date you started the covered activity




OBPS Registration – Dashboard (draft)




OBPS Registration – Add new application (draft)




OBPS Registration – Regulated Parties (draft)




OBPS Registration – Facility Information (draft)
