Business that provide support and maintenance service, including urgent repair, to maintain the safety, security, sanitation and essential operation of institutional, commercial industrial and residential properties and buildings, including property management services, plumbers, electricians custodial/janitorial workers, cleaning services, security services, fire safety and sprinkler systems, building systems maintenance and repair technicians and engineers, mechanics (e.g. HVAC, escalator and elevator technicians), and other service providers who provide similar services.



ELECTRICAL COSTS: RECENT ONTARIO ANNOUNCEMENT





DOES THIS APPLY TO MY CONDOMINIUM?

• God is in the details:

- The announced rebate only applies to customers on time-of-use billing (TOU). These customers will pay 10.1 cents per kWh any time electricity is used
- The rate change is because of the Government of Ontario Emergency Order and will remain in place for the duration of the order (currently expected to be 45 days).
- The 31.8% Ontario Energy Rebate still applies
- No action is required (if you don't see it on your next bill depending on the cycle you will receive a credit)
- Sub-metered suites, billed by the utility will receive this rebate
- We anticipate that sub-metered suites billed by a private metering company will be treated <u>the</u> <u>same way the bulk bill is treated</u>



CAN MY CONDOMINIUM SWITCH TO GET THIS DISCOUNT?



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UNLIKELY...

• God is in the details:

- The corporation would need to have the correct meter to handle time-of-use billing
- Buildings can only make a switch (provided they have the right kind of meter) after the current billing period has ended (so you'd miss out on some savings)
- Most utility customer service departments are only addressing Move-Ins and Move-Outs (urgent/emergency issues only). I don't believe there is anyone to process this change.


